

WYOMING FREE LIBRARY RE-OPENING PLAN

In accordance with the CDC and the Office of Commonwealth Libraries, the Wyoming Free Library will reopen to the public on Monday, July 13.

Hours of operation:

Monday – Wednesday: 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

Thursday: CLOSED

Friday: 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

Saturday: 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

For the safety of all staff and patrons, the following guidelines are set in place.

1. In accordance with Governor Wolf's state order: masks, bandanas, or face coverings are required while visiting the library.
2. Patrons are to enter the library using the glass front door and exit using the rear door which opens into the parking lot.
3. All children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
4. Social distance guidelines will be observed within the library.
5. A total of 15 patrons can use the library at one time.
6. The time limit per visit is 45 minutes.
7. There are 3 public computers available. Computer usage is limited to 45 minutes. Computer stations will be cleaned after each use.
8. There is no public seating due to social distance guidelines.
9. All library materials will be returned in the outside book return. Returned materials will be placed in quarantine for three days.
10. Staff will make photocopies for patrons.
11. One family at a time can access the Children's Room for 30 minutes. The door to the room will be closed while occupied. Table surfaces, computers and table tops will be cleaned after each visit.
12. Curbside pickup requested by phone will be available for patrons who do not want to enter the library.
13. Holds will only be available for Wyoming Free Library items.
14. Interlibrary Loan is not allowed at this time.
15. The Community Room is closed to all outside groups and programming as it is used as a quarantine area for all returned materials.

For the safety of the staff and other patrons, we ask that you stay home if you are sick.
